NORTH LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT SAFE BOATING GUIDLINES 2022

- No Wake surfing and other slow towing operations that produce large wakes on the <u>Little Lake</u>. These should only be done on the big lake and as close to the middle of the lake as possible. No pulled skiers or wake boat operation over sand bars and between the sunken island and shore at the south end of the big lake.
- Quiet time observing "Slow-No-Wake" shall be observed after 6:00 PM on weekends and holidays from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Operation of all powered vessels, including PWC, should be at Slow-No-Wake speed.
- All wake producing boats should stay at least <u>250 ft from shore</u> and 100 ft from piers, rafts, persons
 and other vessels. Other vessels (Operating at Slow-no-wake) should stay closer to shore when wake
 traffic is present on the lake.
- Always watch for swimmers and other boats (kayaks, paddle boards, canoes).

- Please be courteous and respectful of other users on the lake. Accidents can be prevented by being aware of what is ahead and stopping or slowing down to avoid other craft or swimmers.
